Prague Sounds festival gets underway, featuring Nils Frahm's 'Music for Prague' and Laura Mvula's spectacular synth-pop

Prague 13. 10. 2022 – The music festival Prague Sounds, formerly known as Strings of Autumn, starts on October 23rd. Over the course of a month, it offers up eight unique concert-going experiences, including some Prague debuts and unique musical collaborations.

The festival kicks off on October 23rd at the Lucerna Grand Hall with acclaimed American ensemble **Snarky Puppy**, who've won a slew of awards in categories ranging from jazz to R&B. They come to Prague on the back of their Grammywinning album *Live at the Royal Albert Hall*. Charismatic British singer **Laura Mvula** will play Roxy on November 16th in an all-new incarnation, playing songs from her recent album *Pink Noise*, a glittering re-imagining of 80s synth-pop. And German neoclassical composer and electronica guru Nils Frahm will perform an exclusive set called 'Music for Prague' on 24th November at Forum Karlin. Frahm's breathtaking one-man shows are like musical alchemy, as he mixes basslines and beats in real time while moving between an arsenal of keyboard instruments – from harmonium to Rhodes to toy piano to Steinway grand.

Mandolin virtuoso and Punch Brothers frontman **Chris Thile** plays an intimate solo show at La Fabrika on October 24th, encompassing bluegrass, blues, and even Bach. Berlin acoustic-electronica pioneers the **Brandt Brauer Frick Ensemble** make their festival debut at Dox+ on November 1st with a full 10-piece band. The following day, the iconic jazz quartet of **Joshua Redman**, **Brad Mehldau**, **Christian McBride**, and **Brian Blade** perform a long-awaited reunion show at Lucerna Grand Hall. When they first emerged as a band in the 90s, they took jazz by storm. Each of the members subsequently went on to forge a successful solo career, and this chance to see them perform together again is a dream come true for many jazz fans. The festival returns to La Fabrika on 13th Noveymber for a concert featuring **Makaya McCraven**, the drummer known as the 'beat scientist,' whose music brings together elements of hip-hop, jazz, and the avant-garde. And on 19th November, there's a special concert at Rudolfinum to celebrate Czech jazz legend Jiří Stivín's 80th birthday, featuring special guest appearances.


